

- 1. A new Club may have up to 2 Sponsor Clubs, but a Sponsor Club is not required.
- 2. A minimum of 15 New Club Members are required to qualify for a Charter of a New Club. (Refer to Policy IC-51)
- 3. A minimum of 9 of the New Club Members are required to be present at an Official Organizational Meeting to hold the meeting.
- 4. New US and Canadian Clubs are required to pay \$325 to Optimist International.
- 5. New Clubs in Developing Nations are required to pay a new Club fee of \$225. College Clubs are assessed with an annual affiliation fee of \$100.
- 6. Builders of Excellence:
 - a. If there is one Sponsor Club there may be a maximum of two Builders of Excellence.
 - b. If there are two Sponsor Clubs there may be a maximum of four Builders of Excellence.
 - c. There can be up to four Builders of Excellence and two sponsor Clubs.
- 7. An Authorized Representative of Optimist International must be present to conduct the Official Organizational Meeting and certify the paperwork for a New Club
- 8. An officer of the new Club must apply for a tax identification number (EIN) as Optimist International can no longer provide this information for new Clubs. Instructions will be provided to the Club officer after organization.
- 9. A New Club's Charter Roster stays open for 15 days following the Official Organization of a New Club, unless the Club is organized after September 15. Then, the charter roster remains open until only September 30.
