



EMERGENCY WEATHER PROCEDURE

El Campeon Course

When potentially dangerous weather is in the area a horn will sound one long blast. All players should mark the position of their ball and seek the nearest shelter from the threatening conditions. When it is determined that the conditions no longer exist and play is to resume a horn will sound two short blasts. Players are to proceed to the previously marked ball position and replace their ball or another ball and continue play.

Potential dangerous weather will be monitored by the Mission Inn Golf Pro Shop and Optimist on-course officials. There are times when lightning is in the area but may not be visible to the eye. Once play has been suspended, Optimist/Mission Inn staff will transport the players to the clubhouse as soon as possible and then the spectators will be transported.

**NOTE: ALL PRACTICE AREAS ARE CLOSED DURING THE SUSPENSION OF PLAY.
PENALTY FOR VIOLATING THE SUSPENSION: DISQUALIFICATION**
