International Development – Pilot Program and Dues Structure

End of ID Pilot Program

Motion adopted

That the Board of Directors ends the current pilot program for International Development effective September 30, 2022.

International Club Dues Structure

Motion adopted

That the dues structure for international clubs chartered under the International Development Pilot Program prior to July 1, 2022, have their dues adjusted over a three-year period to meet the dues for Developing countries as outlined in our policies, as follows:

- 1. Member dues adjusted to \$20 per member effective 10/1/2022 and affiliation fees dropped
- 2. Member dues adjusted to \$30 per member effective 10/1/2023
- 3. Member dues adjusted to full developing country dues amount on 10/1/2024

International Clubs Dues in Compliance with Policy IC-35

That the above dues structure be automated as per all other Club dues and that the policies established in Club Disbandment and Charter Revocation Procedures (Policy IC-35) be followed for all international Optimist Clubs.

International Clubs in Compliance with International Bylaws

That the Board of Directors withdraws the Special Needs Bylaws Amendment Proposal being offered to the delegates at the July 2022 International Convention.

Special Need Pilot Program & Ad Hoc Special Needs Committee

Motion adopted as amended

That the Board of Directors pauses the current special needs club program with clubs effective and in the database by 6/30/22 and built by 9/30 and refers the program to an Ad Hoc committee to review how to best serve these members with regards to risk management and financial sustainability. Life Member Application Fee

Motion adopted as amended

That the Board of Directors immediately update the Master Schedule of Dues and Fees to revise the Life Membership Application Fee to \$675.80 as required by the Optimist International Bylaws.

Canadian Currency Cap
